In front of you is the crochet pattern for a babywearing mom with a baby, and different babywearing methods. Choose your favorite babywearing way and put these in sight as a lovely reminder of you babywearing days.

My name is Charlotte, in addition to businesswomen, wife of and mother of a son and daughter, I am a babywearingmom, babywearingconsultant and crochet fanatic.

Because of my expertise in SSC's I started designing, a crocheted carrier had to come off my hands. But he, what is a baby carrier without a baby or a mom. The search for the right dimensions & proportions was born. Together with the testers we have put the finishing touches on the pattern and the result is in front of you.

Over the years I have read and made lots of different crochet patterns. As a result, I have developed my own style and preference. I always read a pattern first and add the round numbers that are not yet in it. These are already in there.

I don't like the stitching of the loose parts afterwards and I don't always like them.

I have done this beforehand and made sure that you crochet this with the bodies of mom and baby.

This way it is more pleasant for yourself and safer for your little one, should he or she ever get it. Please note: it is not and will **not** be a children's toy.

The pattern is made for experienced and advanced crocheters. Anyone can do it! If you have any questions, please contact me. Then we'll look at a solution together. Lots of crochet and have fun with this pattern.

Babywearing Mama

Rounds

This pattern is worked in rounds, a spiral. You don't turn your work when working in rounds. You simply continue and mark the first stitch for every new round. This way you know exactly where your round started.

Arms

Start with hook 2,5mm and Abricot

Round 1 start 6 sc in a magic ring = 6

Tip: close the magic ring and croched the tread along with the rounds.

Round 2 [1sc, inc in 2nd] x3 = 9

Round 3 sc in all 9 st = 9

Round 4 [2sc, inc in 3rd] $\times 3 = 12$

Round 5 sc in all 12 st = 12

Round 6 [2sc, dec 3rd & 4th] x3 = 9

Fill: Just fill the hand.

Changing color

- 1. With the last sc of the previous round, don't complete the sc completely. pull the thread through the loop, pull the thread back, you now have a loop, now put the next color on your crochet hook and pick-up the next loop with your crochet hook and pass the thread through both loops. Your next color is on top.
- 2. Crocheting the remaining color changed thread, this saves you hiding ends work. At the next round you crochet these threads immediately. Pick up the loop put the threads on your work and finish the sc. Continue this until the end of the threads. At the end of your project, you won't see it.









Sleeves:

- o No sleeves, continue with Apricot
- o Short sleeves, switch to Green at round 16
- o Long sleeves, switch to Green at round 6



Round 7-16 sc in all 9 st: 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 = 9 Toer 7 - 16

Round 17-20 sc in all 9 st: 17 18 19 20 = 9

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends. Make a second arm.

Insert the chenille wire through the arms.

Crochet the arms along with round 59 of the torso.



Dress, torso & head

Start with Green and hook 2,5mm

Dress

Round 1 start 6sc in a magic ring

Tip: close the magic ring and croched the tread along with the rounds.

Round 2 inc. 6 times = 12

Round 3 [sc, inc. in 2nd st] x6 = 18

Round 4 [sc, inc. in 2nd st, sc] x6 = 24

Round 5 [3 sc, inc. in 4th st] x6 = 30

Round 6 [2 sc, inc. in 3rd st, 2 sc] x6 = 36

Round 7 [5 sc, inc. in 6th st] x6 = 42 Toer 7

Round 8 [3 sc, inc. in 4th st, 3sc] x6 = 48

Round 9 [7sc, inc. in 8th st] x6 = 54

Round 10 [4sc, inc. In 5th st, 4sc] x6 = 60

Round 11 [sc, inc. in second st] x30 = 90

Round 12 sc in all 90 st back loop only = 90

Change to Multicolor Sunset

Tip: With stripes, you don't cut the treads. You leave them hanging until you need them again.

Round 13-14 sc in all 90 st 13 14 =90

Change to Green

Round 15-16 sc in all 90 st 15 16 =90

Change to Multicolor Sunset

Round 17-18 sc in all 90 st 17 18 =90

Change to Green

Round 19 sc in all 90 st 19 = 90



Decrease

Begin by working as a single crochet (sc) only through the front loop. Then insert your hook into the following stitch through the front loop, wrap the yarn over your hook and pull it through the two front loops only (three loops on the hook). Wrap the yarn over the hook again and through the loops on the hook to complete the stitch.

Round 20 [13sc, dec. 14^{th} & 15^{th}] x6 = 84

Round 21-22 sc in all 84 st 21 22 = 84

Round 23 [6sc, dec 7th & 8th, 6sc] x6 = 78

Round 24-25 sc in all 78 st $24 \ 25 = 78$

Round 26 [11sc, dec. 12th & 13th] x6 = 72

Round 27-28 sc in all 72 st 27 28 = 72

Round 29 [5sc, dec. 6th & 7th 5sc] x6 = 66

Round 30-31 sc in all 66 st $\frac{30}{31} = 66$

Round 32 [9sc, dec. 10th & 11th] x6 60

Round 33-34 sc in all 60 st 33 34 =60

Round 35 [4sc, dec. 5th & 6th, 4sc] x6 = 54

Round 36-37 sc in all 54 st 36 37 = 54

Fill up: Now place the tights with granulate gravel filling on the bottom.

Always put your work straight a side, so the bottom stays the most flat







Round 38 [7sc, dec. 8th & 9th] x6 48

Round 39-40 sc in all 48 st 39 + 40 = 48

Round 41 [3sc, dec. 4th & 5th, 3sc] x6 = 42

Round 42-43 sc in all 42 st 42 43 = 42

Round 44 [5sc, dec. 6th & 7th] x6 = 36



Torso

Round 45 sc in all 36 st **front loop only** = 36

Round 46-54 sc in all 36 st 46 47 48 49 50 51 52 53 54 = 36

Round 55 [2sc, dec. 3rd & 4th, 2sc] x6 = 30

Fill: Fill up the torso well and firmly

Round 56-58 sc in all 30 st 56 57 58 = 30

Tip: The chenille wire is for bending the arms around the baby. It's like mom giving the baby a hug. If the chenille wire is too long, insert the excess back through the torso.

Arms: crochet the arm along. The chenille wire is already in the arms. Crochet the arms along with round 59. Make sure that the chenille wire is in the middle of the 4sc.

Round 59 10sc, 4sc with the 1st arm, 10sc, 4sc with the 2nd arm, 2sc = 30



Round 60 [3sc, dec. 4th & 5th] x6 = 24

Round 61-62 sc in all 24 st 61 62 = 24

Round 63 [1sc, dec. 2nd & 3rd, 1sc] x6 = 18

Change to Abricot

Filling: Fill the body firmly, the baby may hang on it. Make sure that the chenille wire remains on the back as much as possible.



Head

Round 64 sc in all 18 st front loop only = 18

Round 65 [1sc, inc. in 2nd st, 1sc] \times 6 front loop only = 24

Round 66 **both loops** [3sc, inc. In 4th] x6 = 30

Round 67 [2sc, inc. in 3rd st, 2sc] = 36

Round 68 [5sc, inc. in 6th st] x6 = 42

Round 69 [3sc, inc in 4th st, 3sc] x6 = 48

Round 70 [7sc, inc in 8th st] x6 = 54

Round 71 [4sc, inc in 5th, 4sc] \times 6 = 60

Eyes: At round **74 & 75**, you need a string for the placement of the eyes, with 8sc in between. 39sc, 1sc with the string, 8sc, 1sc with the string, 11sc.



Round 81 [4sc, dec 5th & 6th, 4sc] x6 = 54

Round 82 [7sc, dec 8th & 9th] x6 = 48

Round 83 [3sc, dec 4th & 5th, 3sc] x6 = 42

Round 84 [5sc, dec 6th & 7th]x6 = 36

Eyes: Place the safety eyes 8mm.



Fill: Fill the head and keep filling until the last round.



Round 85 [2sc, dec 3rd & 4th, 2sc] x6 = 30

Round 86 [3sc, dec 4th & 5th] x6 = 24

Round 87 [1sc, dec 2nd & 3rd, 1sc] x6 = 18

Round 88 [1sc, dec 2nd & 3rd] x6 = 12

Round 89 dec 6 times = 6

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.



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Hat/ Hair



Tip: If you want a hat instead of hair, pick your color and change at the end of round 20 to Honey.

Start with hook 2,5mm and Honey

Round 1 start 6 sc in a magic ring = 6

Tip: close the magic ring and crochet the tread along with the rounds.

Round 2 inc. 6 times = 12

Round 3 [sc, inc. in 2nd st] x6 = 18

Round 4 [sc, inc. in 2nd st, sc] x6 = 24

Round 5 [3 sc, inc. in 4th st] x6 = 30

Round 6 [2 sc, inc. in 3rd st, 2 sc] x6 = 36

Round 7 [5 sc, inc. in 6th st] x6 = 42

Round 8 [3 sc, inc. in 4th st, 3sc] x6 = 48

Round 9 [7sc, inc. in 8th st] x6 = 54

Round 10 [4sc, inc. In 5th st, 4sc] x6 = 60

Round 11-20 sc in all 60 st 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 = 60

Tip: Choose your hairstyle and continue there with round 20

Don't you want hair? Just hook to round 20 and put the hat on the head.

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends. Put the hat on the head.





Long hair



Tip: crochet with crochethook 2mm Round 20 sc in all 60 st = 60

Hair:

These are the short hairs/bangs on the front [Chain of 5,

1 sl st in the 2nd stitch form your hook, 3 sc,

Skip 1 stitch on the edge, 1 sl st] x10

These are the long hairs at the back [Chain of 30,

1 sl st in the 2nd stitch form your hook, 28 sc,

Skip 1 stitch on the edge, 1 sl st] x20





Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.

Put the hair on the head







Short hair



Tip: crochet with crochet hook 2mm

Round 20 sc in all 60 st = 60

Hair:

[Chain of 6,

1 sl st in the 2nd stitch form your hook,

4sc,

Skip 1 stitch on the edge, 1 sl st] x30





Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.

Put the hair on the head





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Braids



Tip: crochet with crochet hook 2mm Round 20 sc in all 60 st = 60 Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.

Braid:

- Cut 60 threads about 40cm long;
- Put the hair with the open side up in front of you. Insert your crochet hook from the outside inwards;
- Fold the threads (per piece) in half and insert the loop of the double folded thread through the sc using your crochet hook; 1 thread per sc;
- Repeat for all the 60 threads;
- Divide the threads into 2 equal pieces and turn each piece into a braid;
- $_{\circ}$ Tie a thread around the bottom of the braid and fasten the thread with a double knot.

Put the hair on the head

Bun



Start with hook 2,5mm and Honey

Round 1 start 6sc in a magic ring

Tip: close the magic ring and crochet the tread along with the rounds.

Round 2 inc. 6 times = 12

Round 3 [sc, inc. in 2nd st] x6 = 18

Round 4 [sc, inc. in 2nd st, sc] $\times 6 = 24$

Round 5 [3 sc, inc. in 4th st] x6 = 30

Round 6-10 sc in all 30 st 6 7 8 9 10 = 30

Change to Multicolor Sunset

Tip: Don't cut the Honeytread yet, let the tread hang for the next 3 rounds.

Round 11 [3sc, dec 4th & 5th] x6 = 24

Round 12 sc in all 24 st = 24

Round 13 [1sc, dec 2nd & 3rd, 1sc] x6 = 18

Change back to **Honey**, crochet the chopped **Multicolor Sunset** tread along immediately

Round 14 [sc, inc. In 2nd st, sc] x6 = 24

Round 15 [3 sc, inc. In 4th st] x6 = 30

Round 16 [2 sc, inc. In 3rd st, 2 sc] x6 = 36

Round 17 [5 sc, inc. In 6th st] x6 = 42

Round 18 [3 sc, inc. in 4th st, 3sc] x6 = 48

Round 19 [7sc, inc. in 8th st] x6 = 54

Round 20 [4sc, inc. In 5th st, 4sc] x6 = 60

Round 21-29 sc in all 60 st 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 = 60



Tip: crochet with crochet hook 2mm

Round 30 sc in all 60 st = 60

Round 31:

These are the short hairs/bangs on the front

[Chain of 5;

1 sl st in the 2nd stitch form your hook;

3 sc;

Skip 1 stitch on the edge, 1 sl st] x10

Decorative round for the remaining 40sc:

[Skip 1sc of the edge;

3sc in the next sc;

Skip 1sc on the edge;

1 sl st] x10

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends. Fill up the bun. Put the hair on the head





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Baby



Arms

Start with hook 2,5mm and Abricot

Round 1 start 5 sc in a magic ring = 5

Tip: close the magic ring and crochet the tread along with the rounds.

Round 2-4 sc in all 5 st $2 \ 3 \ 4 = 5$

Round 5 fold the arm in half and crochet the arm close with 3sc

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends. Make a second arm.

Crochet the arms along with round 12 of the body

Legs

Start with hook 2.5mm and Abricot

Round 1 start 6 sc in a magic ring = 6

Tip: close the magic ring and crochet the tread along with the rounds.

Round 2-7 sc in all 6 st 2 3 4 5 6 7 = 6

Round 8 fold the leg in half and crochet the leg close with 3sc

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends. Make a second leg.

Crochet the legs along with round 3 of the body.



Crochet arms and legs

You need a 2nd crochet hook for convenience, preferably one smaller than your crochet already with. This way you can easily pick up the loop you are going to crochet with.

- Determine the right place for your arm(s) and legs.
 - o This is indicated in the pattern.
- Put the leg against your work, against the outside
- Insert the (other) crochet hook through both opposite stitches of the arm or lea
- Through the stitch of your work
- Pick up the loop on the inside of your work and pull the loop through all the stitches
- Place the loop over the crochet hook of your work and complete the stitch.
- Proceed to the next sc and repeat the steps above
- This way you continue until you have the entire arm or leg (3á4sc).
- Continue the round and hook the second leg or arm with it and your round is finished.

Daiper, body & head

Start with hook 2,5mm and Green

Round 1 start 6 sc in a magic ring = 6

Tip: close the magic ring and crochet the tread along with the rounds.

Round 2 inc 6 times = 12

Round 3 you need the legs!!! inc 12 times = 24

Legs: Place the leg against the beautiful (outside) side of your work. This way you can hook the legs along with round 3 immediately. In each sc go 2sc. Insert your crochet hook through all the stitches at once. The is as follows:

- 2sc in the first 2 sc of round 2
- 2 sc and the first stitch of the leg;
- 2 sc and the second stitch of the leg;
- 2 sc and the third stitch of the leg;
- 2 sc in the next sc:
- 2 sc and the first stitch of the leg;
- 2 sc and the second stitch of the leg;
- 2 sc and the third stitch of the leg;
- 2 sc in the last 3 sc of round 2.



Round 4 [3sc, inc in 4th] x6 =30 Round 5-7 sc in all 30 st 5 6 7 =30 Change to **Abricot**

Round 8 sc in all 30 st = 30

Round 9 [3sc, dec 4th & 5th] x6 = 24

Round 10 [1sc, dec 2nd & 3rd, 1sc] x6 = 18

Round 11 [1sc, dec 2nd & 3rd] x6 = 12

Fill: Make it a nice big baby belly

Arms: Place the arm against the top of your work and hook the arms along stitch by stitch. Stick your hook through all the stitches of the arm and the head.



Crochet the arms along with round 12 as follows: 2sc, arm, arm, arm, 3sc, arm, arm, 1sc Haak de armen mee met round 12 als volgt: 2v, arm, arm, arm, 3v, arm, arm, arm, 1v

Round 12 sc in all 12 st along with the arms = 12

Round 13 sc in all 12 st front loop only = 12 Round 14 [1sc, inc in 2nd] $\times 6 = 18$

Round 15 [1sc, inc in 2nd, 1sc] x6 = 24

Round 16 [3sc, inc in 4th] x6 = 30

Eyes: At round **19 & 20**, you need a string for the placement of the eyes, with 4sc in between. Pay close attention to the location of the legs.

Round 17-21 sc in all 30 st 17 18 **19 20** 21 = 30 Round 22 [3sc, dec 4th & 5th] \times 6 = 24



Eyes: Are the eyes in the right place? Yes, now you can place the eyes 6mm. No, adjust them and then place them.



Round 23 [1sc, dec 2nd & 3rd, 1sc] x6 = 18 Toer 23 [Haak 1v, 2^e en 3^e v samenhaken, 1v] x6 = 18v **Fill:** Fill up the head and keep on filling until the last round.

Round 24 [1sc, dec 2nd & 3rd] x6 = 12

Round 25 dec 6 times = 6

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.





Hat & Bonnet



Start with hook 2,5mm and Green

Round 1 start 6 sc in a magic ring = 6

Tip: close the magic ring and crochet the tread along with the rounds.

Round 2 inc. 6 times = 12

Round 3 [sc, inc. in 2nd st] $\times 6 = 18$

Round 4 [sc, inc. in 2nd st, sc] x6 = 24

Round 5 [3 sc, inc. in 4th st] x6 = 30

Round 6-10 sc in all 30 st 6 $\frac{7}{8}$ 9 $\frac{10}{9}$ = 30

Tip: crochet round 11 with crochet hook 2mm

Hat

Round 11 sc in all 30 st = 30 Haak 30v = 30v

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.

Put the hat on the head

Bonnet continues on the next page





Bonnet



Round 11

- o Chain of 41
- o 1sc in the 2nd stitch form your hook, 39sc in the rest & 1 sl st in the last,
- o 1sc in the first sc of round 11, 14sc =15sc
- o Chain of 41,
- o 1sc in the 2nd stitch form your hook, 39sc, & 1 sl st in the last,
- o 1sc in in the 15th sc of round 11, 14sc.

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends. Put the bonnet on the head



Row

The rows go back and forth, with one chain at the end of the row, each time. This chain gives you the space to turn your work to the other side. If you don't do this, the work starts to warp.

Wrap



Start with hook 2,5mm and **Mutlicolor Sunset** Begin met haaknaald 2,5 met Multicolor Row 1 Chain of 201

Row 2 1sc in the 2nd stitch from your hook, 198hdc, 2hdc in the last, and turn = 1sc, 200hdc

Decrease: Begin by working as a single crochet (sc) (two loops on the hook). Then insert your hook into the following stitch, wrap the yarn over your hook and pull it through the stitch only (three loops on the hook). Wrap the yarn over the three loops on the hook to complete the stitch.

Row 3 2chain, 2hdc dec as a sc, 196hdc, 2hdc in the last and turn = 1sc, 198hdc
Row 4 2chain, 2hdc in the first hdc, 194hdc, 2hdc dec as a sc and turn 196hdc, 1sc
Row 5 1chain, 2hdc dec as a sc, 194hdc, 2hdc in the last and turn = 1sc,194hdc
Row 6 2chain, 2hdc in the first hdc, 192hdc, 2hdc dec as a sc and turn = 192hdc, 1sc
Row 7 1chain, 2hdc dec as a sc, 190hdc, 2hdc in the last and turn = 1sc, 190hdc
Row 8 2chain, 2hdc in the first hdc, 188hdc, 2hdc dec as a sc and turn = 190hdc, 1sc

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.



Ringsling



Start with hook 2,5mm and Mutlicolor Sunset

Row 1 chain of 76

Row 2 1hdc in the 2nd sc from your hook, 72hdc in the rest, 1sc in the last and turn = 73hdc,1sc

Row 3 1 chain, 2hdc dec as a sc, 70hdc, and turn = 1sc, 70hdc

Make sure you hook the hdc together and not the sc.

Row 4 2chain, 69hdc, 1sc in the last and turn = 69hdc, 1sc

Row 5 1 chain, 2hdc dec as a sc, 67hdc, and turn = 1sc, 67hdc

Make sure you hook the hdc together and not the sc.

Row 6 2chain, 66hdc, 1sc in the last and turn = 66hdc, 1sc

Row 7 1 chain 2hdc dec as a sc, 65hdc and turn = 1sc, 65hdc

Make sure you hook the hdc together and not the sc.

Row 8 2chain, 65hdc, 1sc in the last and turn = 65hdc, 1sc

Row 9 1 chain, 2hdc dec as a sc, 64 hdc = 1sc, 64hdc

Make sure you hook the hdc together and not the sc.

Row 10 Place your ringsling with the short side at the top and place the rings on top.

Crochet the ringsling on to the rings: place the rings against your work (with the round side at the top) pick up the loop through your work and make a sc. Do this for the entire short side.



Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.



Meh Dai



Start with hook 2,5mm and Multicolor Sunset

Row 1 chain of 8 = 8

Row 2 1hdc in the 2nd chain from your hook, 6hdc, 1 chain and turn = 7hdc

Row 3 2hdc in the first, 5hdc, 2hdc in the last, 1 chain and turn = 9hdc

Row 4 2hdc in the first, 7hdc, 2hdc in the last, 1chain and turn = 11hdc

Row 5 2hdc in the first, 9hdc, 2hdc in the last, 1chain and turn = 13hdc

Row 6 2hdc in the first, 11hdc, 2hdc in the last, 1 chain and turn = 15hdc

Row 7 2hdc in the first, 13hdc, 2hdc in the last, 1 chain and turn = 17hdc

Row 8 2hdc in the first, 15 hdc, 2hdc in the last, 1 chain and turn = 19hdc

Row 9 19hdc in all hdc = 19hdc

Row 10 chain of 51, this will be the first shoulder strap = 51

Row 11 1sc in the 2nd chain from your hook, 49sc = 50sc

Row 12 crochet 8sc on the side of the backpanel = 8sc

Row 13 chain of 31, this will be the first piece of the waistband = 31

Waistband Crochet trough in 1 piece around the carrier:

Row 14

- 1sc in the 2nd chain from your hook, 29sc = 30sc
- 7sc in the other side of the chain from row 1 = 7sc
 - o **Tip:** Crochet the begin wire along immediately
- chain of 31, this will be the second piece of the waistband = 31
- 1sc in the 2nd chain from your hook, 29sc = 30sc

Row 15 crochet 8sc on the side of the backpanel = 8sc

Row 16 chain of 51, this will be the second shoulder strap = 51

Row 17 1sc in the 2nd chain from your hook, 49sc = 50sc

Row 18 1sc, 15hdc, 1sc on the top of the backpanel = 1sc, 15hdc, 1sc Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.

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Onbuhimo



Start with hook 2,5mm and Multicolor Sunset

Row 1 start with chain of 18 = 18

Row 2 1hdc in the 3rd chain from your hook, 15hdc, 2 chain and turn = 16hdc

Row 3 2hdc dec, 12 hdc, 2hdc dec, 2 chain and turn = 14hdc

Row 4 2hdc dec, 10 hdc, 2hdc dec, 2 chain and turn = 12hdc

Row 5 2hdc dec, 8 hdc, 2hdc dec, 2 chain and turn = 10hdc

Row 6 2hdc dec, 6hdc, 2hdc dec, 2 chain and turn = 8hdc

Row 7-8 8hdc in all st, 2chain and turn = 8hdc

Row 9 2hdc in the first, 6hdc, 2hdc in the last, 2chain and turn = 10hdc

Row 10 2hdc in the first, 8hdc, 2hdc in the last, 2chain and turn = 12hdc

Row 11 2hdc in the first, 10hdc, 2hdc in the last, 2chain and turn = 14hdc

Row 12 2hdc in the first, 12hdc, 2hdc in the last, 2chain and turn = 16hdc

Row 13 16hdc in all st = 16hdc

Row 14 chain of 17, secure the chain with a sc at the top of the backpanel, 15sc, chain of 17, secure the chain with a sc at the bottom of the backpanel, 15sc

Row 15 15sc in the chain on the **OUTSIDE**, 15 sl st on the top of the backpanel,

Row 16 15sc in the 2nd chain, 15 sl st on the bottom of the backpanel.

Fasten off and hide the yarns end.



Attach at the vertex on the inside of the carrier.

Make sure that the shoulder straps are on top.

Crochet $17\acute{a}18sc$ along the side of the carrier, $15\,sl$ st on the **INSIDE** of the shoulder strap.

Do this with **both** shoulder straps.

Fasten off and hide the yarn ends.









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Congratulations. You're all set now!!

If you've made everything, you can change it up. How to put everything on?

Wrap

- o Fold the wrap in half for finding the middle
- o Put baby in, with baby facing mom,
- o Place the middle of the wrap on the back of the baby
- o Place the loose straps under the armpits of mom and cross on the back over the shoulders
- o Make a cross under the bum and go back to the front, tie a double knot.

Ringsling

- Put the oblique end through both rings
- Open the rings
- o Bring the oblique side back over the 1st ring and through the 2nd ring
- o now you can adjust it, so the baby can sit in it
 - (beware of the opening of the keyring it may linger in your crochet piece)

Meh Dai

Front carry

- Tie the waistband knot on the mom's back
- o Put baby in, with baby facing mom,
- o Place the Meh Dai's back panel over baby's back
- Shoulder straps go over mom's shoulders, crosses and back forward,
- o Under the baby's bum, fasten the shoulder straps with a double knot.

Back carrying

- o Tie the waistband knot on the mom's belly
- o Place baby, facing mom's back,
- Place the Meh Dai's back panel over baby's back
- Shoulder straps go forward over mom's shoulder, cross and backward
 - We don't usually cross on the chest. Crossing prevents the arms of the babywearing mama from being pulled back unnecessarily.
- o Under the baby's bum, fasten the shoulder straps with a double knot.



Onbuhimo

- o Put the baby with his back into the Onbuhimo
- o Place the baby in the Onbuhimo on mom's back as follows:
- o Put the mom's arms through the shoulder straps
- o Position baby well on mom's back

Bonnet put it on 1:

- o Put on the bonnet,
- o crosses on the chest,
- o under the armpits trough to the back,
- o Tie a double knot.

Bonnet put it on 2:

- o Put on the bonnet,
- Straight back under the armpits,
- o crosses on the back,
- o cross to the chest,
- Tie a double knot.





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
